

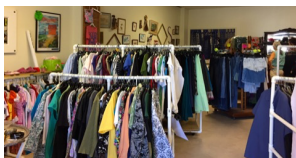
## Spay & Neuter / Our Store / About Anguilla

We work with Morlens to hold spay/neuter events, including low cost or free surgeries for the community.

Since 2003, we've completed over 3,000 surgeries! As would be expected, this has made a noticeable impact on the number of unwanted and stray animals.

### Thrift Store and AARF Merchandise

Our Second Chances boutique thrift store helps the community and generates revenue for AARF. We have housewares, clothing, books, electronics and more. Plus, we have AARF merchandise such as hats and shirts.

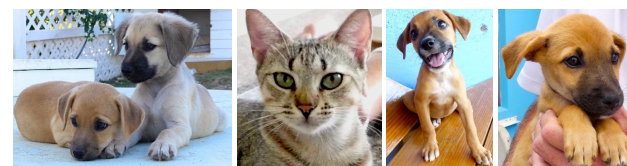

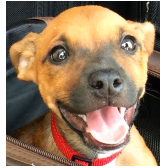
## About AARF / Mission / Adoptions

The Anguilla Animal Rescue Foundation is a non-profit dog and cat rescue organization on the Caribbean Island of Anguilla.



Founded in 2000, AARF has an adoption center and rescue shelter at Morlens Veterinary Clinic.

We are 100% volunteer-driven and solely funded by donors and fundraisers. Our US subsidiary in Florida (AARC) has 501(c)(3) non-profit status, so donations to AARC can qualify for tax purposes.



Our mission is to promote the welfare of Anguillian dogs, puppies, cats and kittens. We support our mission by:

- maintaining the island's only adoption center and rescue shelter
- having active spay and neuter programs that promote surgeries
- running education programs in schools and media
- participating in community events

AARF helps adoptable pets find good homes — both locally and internationally.

Savvy locals know to come to AARF to adopt our great looking and smart puppies and kittens.



But our pets are in such great demand that visitors adopt dozens of pets each year — and once their families and friends meet them, we hear, “I want one too!” And for that, we have our Anguilla Puppy (and Kitten) Express Program.

## Adoption Process

The AARF shelter accepts unwanted dogs, cats, puppies and kittens at no charge from owners or people that find them abandoned, and works with Morlens to make sure those that are adoptable can find good homes.

Adoptable pets get a vet examination, vaccinations and deworming. We then work to find good homes for them.



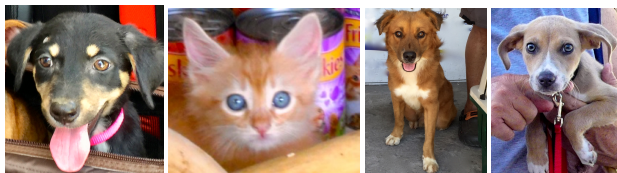
For local adoptions, spay or neuter surgery is required — and is included in the low adoption fee.

## International Adoptions

For international adoptions, AARF helps with what is an easy process for United States and Canadian adoptions. We help visitors adopt and take home by helping with the process, including paperwork and any needed supplies for the trip home. Adoptions to other countries are also possible.

Our adoption numbers are terrific: we've had nearly 2600 adoptions since 2005!

And via the Anguilla Puppy Express Program, we have sent some 500 puppies, dogs, kittens and cats to North America.



## Puppy and Kitten Express

For people wanting a cute Anguillian puppy or kitten but who can't come to Anguilla, we have our Anguilla Puppy Express program (which of course includes kittens!)

Anguilla Puppy Express is a well established transportation program. Volunteers escort puppies and kittens to the USA where they find their forever homes, either through our rescue partners or directly to adoptive families.

We do the paperwork, provide a carrier and travel kit and help with the process, and there is no expense to the volunteer. All the APE volunteer has to do is make a pet reservation with the airline and escort the pet, who will usually be under the seat in front of the traveler on the plane. The traveler is met at the US airport by the adoptive family or one of our rescue partners.

Many people love to transport our pets. In fact, the number of volunteers keep growing and many have transported more than once. They all say it's a wonderful experience and are happy to help find a fantastic forever home in the US.
